Youth Baseball, Sunday, February 5th, 12-2pm

Presenters: Ed Dunn, Nate Fish

There has been a recent surge in youth travel baseball in New York City. Join Ed Dunn from the CP Stars and Nate Fish, manager of the Yorkville Baseball Academy, to discuss youth baseball, how to train smarter, and what it takes for kids to get better. Then jump in the cage with Ed and Nate for an hour of hitting instruction.

High School Baseball, Sunday, February 26th, 12:30pm-2:30pm

Presenter: Matt Roventini

Matt Roventini is the head varsity baseball coach at Poly Prep, the number one ranked high-school baseball team in New York City. Join Matt as he talks about high-school baseball in New York and answers your questions about what it takes to play at that level. Then, Matt will lead an hour of batting practice in the cages.

College Baseball, Sunday, March 4th, Noon-3pm

Presenter: Ralph Roesler

Ralph Roesler is the former hitting instructor at the University of Pennsylvania. Ralph will talk about what it takes to play college baseball, answer questions about recruiting, and will run a 90 minute hitting clinic in the Baseball Academy.

Pro Baseball, Sunday, March 11th, 12-2pm

Presenter: John Foster

John Foster pitched in the Major Leagues for the Atlanta Braves and Milwaukee Brewers from 2002-2005 and is the current pitching coach at Monroe College. John will talk about playing in the Minors, the

Majors, will answer questions about pro baseball, and will lead a pitching clinic in the Baseball Academy following his presentation.

Positive Coaching Alliance, Sunday, March 18th, 12-2pm, and 2-4pm

Presenter: Pat Doyle

Pat Doyle is one of the winningest baseball coaches in California Junior College history, he heads the MLB International Envoy Program that sends teams of coaches into developing countries to teach baseball, and is a representative of the Positive Coaching Alliance, an internationally renowned organization founded at Stanford University that preaches the pillars of good coaching and sportsmanship and includes coaching legends Doc Rivers, Bruce Bochy, and Phil Jackson as members. Join Pat for two separate presentations: coaches presentation from 12-2pm, and a players presentation from 2-4pm.

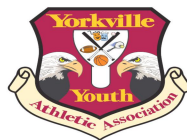
